As you listen to the reading again, imagine yourself there next to Paul as he has his vision and he tells you where you are going next notice the feelings that arise in your heart.

Now as this prayer time comes to an end, are there things you want to pray to God for to help you hear his voice, and recognise his presence in your life? Ask for whatever it is you need to take God's word into our world...
